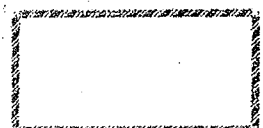
You have to go to the store and pick up a few things for your mom. She has given you a \$50 bill and has told you that you can keep the change but you have to get everything on her list. She needs:
